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6.9 Hikurangi Multiuse Hardcourt – Land Purchase

Meeting: Whangarei District Council

1 Purpose

To seek Council's approval to purchase the Hikurangi tennis courts for \$1.00.

2 Recommendation

That the Council approves the \$1.00 purchase of the Hikurangi tennis courts to enable redevelopment into a multiuse hardcourt facility.

3 Background

The Hikurangi tennis courts are located at 20 Park Street and owned by the Hikurangi Tennis Club. The facility comprises three asphalt tennis courts, hurricane fencing and a small clubroom building. The courts, fences and clubroom have all fallen into disrepair, with the cracked and uneven playing surface limiting recreation value. The court is well situated as part of a recreation hub, with the site adjacent to the bowls club and sports grounds.

To increase amenity value, it was proposed to redevelop the courts into a multiuse facility suitable for use by a number of sporting codes. Consultation identified that the facility should make provision for tennis, soccer/futsal, netball and hockey. The resulting design was a synthetic turf surface (see attached plans), complete with line markings and ancillary fixings for the above sports. The proposed upgrade also includes the installation of court lighting, designed to extend the hours of use and better cater for winter sports/wet weather training.

4 Discussion

The Hikurangi Tennis Club have requested that WDC fund an upgrade of the court facility and take ownership of the land. WDC have agreed to take on the project, with a budget of \$315,000 allocated in the 16/17 Annual Plan. Tenders were called last year, however only one tender was received and considered too expensive. The project has been carried forward and will be re-tendered this financial year.

The Engineer's Estimate is \$235,000 to complete the multiuse hardcourt installation and \$50,000 to install court lighting. A further \$15,000 is anticipated to obtain resource consent and cover legal fees associated with the land acquisition. A high-level cost summary is tabulated below:

The WDC Parks & Recreation Department aims to facilitate a stakeholder committee to administer the new courts. This committee will be responsible for bookings, fees and routine maintenance.
