1 Purpose / Te Kaupapa

To provide an update from Creative Northland on the review of the Whangarei Arts, Culture, and Heritage Strategy goals and actions. The presentation aims to facilitate discussion and gather information and input to refine the goals and actions for the next five years on behalf of the Whangārei District Council.

2 Background / Horopaki
