## 2.1 City Core Precinct Plan Update

### 1 Purpose

To update Council on the City Core Precinct Plan and to seek feedback from Elected Members.

### 2 Discussion

The City Core Precinct Plan sets out a detailed vision for the heart of our city, building on the high level set in the City Centre Plan, which Council adopted last year. It will focus on future land uses, short term projects and longer term projects. This is a necessary step to ensure the vision Council established for the City Centre is implemented.

The plan has been developed in an integrated way, with collaboration across the organisation. A key focus of this has been between our Strategy, Infrastructure, Transport and District Planning departments.

The City Core Precinct Plan has also been guided by engagement with key groups and stakeholders, including one of our most successful Business Sector workshops. Input has also been incorporated from the Bank Street Revitalisation Group, Walking and Cycling Reference Group as well as our Disability, Youth and Positive Aging Advisory Groups.

Prior to the briefing a draft document will be shared with Elected Members to then allow discussion and feedback in the Briefing. Staff will then incorporate this feedback into a finalised document for adoption.
